



Free Disposal of Household Hazardous Waste in Monroe County, Florida



Pulling your hair trying to figure out where you can safely get rid of the hazardous waste piling up in your cabinets and garage? Several times each month **Monroe County** Public Works—Solid Waste, provides **County residents** with the opportunity to dispose of those hazardous products and substances, at the local Transfer Stations, free of charge.

Limits: Amount of residentially generated liquid waste should not exceed twenty five gallons. Multiple trips are allowed.

ACCEPTABLE WASTES ARE:

adhesives	household cleaners
antifreeze	motor oil
auto polish	paints & solvents
aerosol cans	garden chemicals
car batteries	pool chemicals
drain cleaners	household batteries
fluorescent bulbs	weed killer
furniture polish	wood preservatives
